**Kirkwood Park (Sugar Creek Ridge Pavillion - near the tennis courts)**

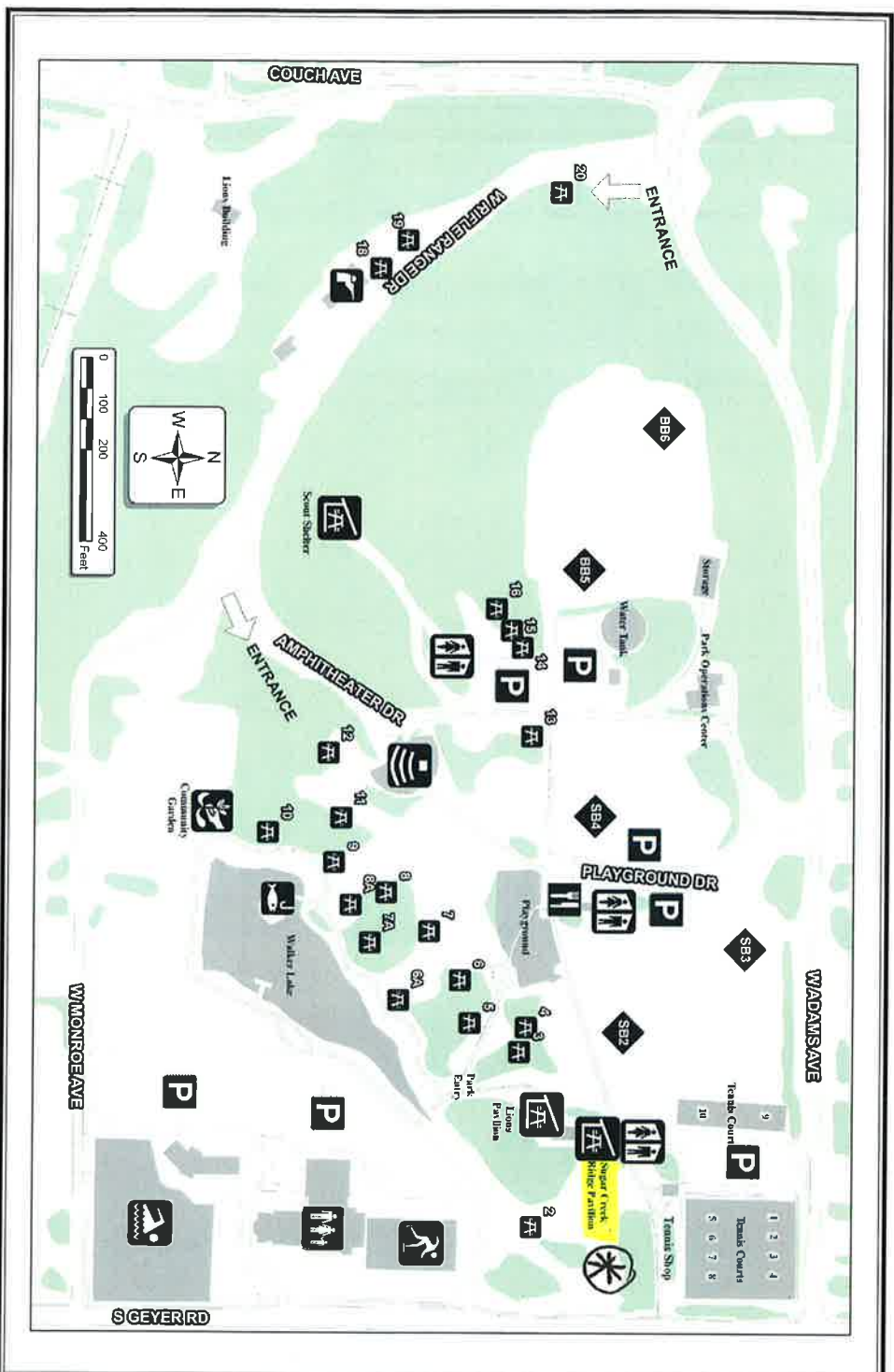
