Shavuot night is an evening dedicated solely to Torah learning. There is little value in staying up through the night if it is not for the purpose of learning Torah in preparation for the holiday of *matan* Torah. It is also important to enhance the atmosphere appropriate for and respectful of the sanctity of the evening.

To help maintain this elevated atmosphere, we have designated 3 separate Beit Midrash locations, as listed above.

In addition, If your child is planning to participate in the Tikun Leil Shavuot, please help us by ensuring that he or she understands the purpose of this experience, is age appropriate, and is committed appropriate behavior. We ask that every middle school child in shul should have a designated adult in shul who can take responsibility for him or her. Thank you for your understanding.

We have organized police security to monitor pedestrian traffic on Delmar. Children will not be allowed to congregate outdoors. Please make sure that your child understands that in order to stay up all night they must be in shul and must be involved in a Torah learning program.
