Shavuot is the holiday of Torah study! We are very proud of our annual Tikun Leil Shavuot which brings the community together in an atmosphere of Torah learning and unity, with educators from Young Israel, TMK, NCSY, Bnei Akiva, Yeshivat Kadimah, and EHA. It is a reflection of the very unity we seek in preparation for Matan Torah.

Please note that the adult shiurim will all take place in the back section of the Beit Midrash. The youth program will take place in designated sections of the sanctuary and social hall.

As we have reiterated in previous years, there is little value in staying up through the night if it is not for the purpose of learning Torah. To help maintain this elevated atmosphere, we have designed the program so that the youth have separate programs for boys and girls. If your child is planning to participate, please help us by ensuring that he/she understands the purpose of this experience, is age appropriate, and is committed to appropriate behavior. The youth program is focused primarily on 8th grade and above. If you have a child in middle school interested in joining please make sure a designated adult will be in shul who will take active responsibility for him/her. have also organized security to monitor pedestrian traffic on Delmar. Children will not be allowed to congregate outside of the synagogue building, in order not to disturb the neighbors. Please make sure that your children understand that in order to participate they must be in shul and involved in a learning program.
