YOUTH PROGRAM SHAVUOT NIGHT GRADES 8 AND ABOVE

Dear Friends:

Shavuot is the holiday of Torah study! We are very proud of our annual *Tikun Leil Shavuot*, which brings the community together in an atmosphere of Torah learning and unity, with educators from Young Israel, TMK, NCSY, Bnei Akiva, Yeshivat Kadimah, EHA and the St. Louis Kollel. It is a reflection of the very unity we seek in preparation for Matan Torah.

Please note that the adult shiurim will all take place in the back section of the Beit Midrash, while the youth program will take place in designated sections of the sanctuary and social hall.

As we have reiterated in previous years, there is little value in staying up through the night if it is not for the purpose of learning Torah. To help maintain this elevated atmosphere, we have designed the program so that the youth are in separate programs for boys and girls, and is specifically focused on students from 8th grade and up only. If your child is planning to participate, please help us by ensuring that he/she understands the purpose of this experience, is age appropriate, and is committed to appropriate behavior.

There will be ongoing shiurim for the teens throughout the night, led by Rabbi Freund, Rabbi Rothstein, Rabbi Rovinsky, Tali Rothstein,

Downstairs in the Beit Midrash there will be chavruta learning throughout the evening. (We ask only that all chavruta study be in samegender groups.)

We have also organized security to monitor pedestrian traffic on Delmar, to secure the perimeter of the building, and to ensure that no inappropriate or unlawful behavior in or around the premises occurs. **Children will not be allowed to congregate outside of the synagogue building, in order not to disturb the neighbors**.

Please make sure that your children understand that in order to participate they must be in shul and involved in a learning program. If you feel that there is a likelihood that your son / daughter will be unable to participate within these guidelines, please refrain from sending them. Please help us ensure a safe, healthy, and spiritual Tikun Leil Shavuot for all, filled with the proper atmosphere and Torah study. Thank you for your understanding and your partnership.
