RH / YK PREPARATIONS: Upon receiving the survey results, as well as responses from a number of members, we have decided that we will go ahead with 3 services for Rosh Hashanah, a hashkamah minyan, the regular minyan upstairs, and a third minyan that will take place outdoors, beneath the overhang parking lot. We hope to send out more information about times and details in the next few days, including a sign-up sheet for each of these minyanim. We will need to make a careful calculation of our capacity at each of these, and we will keep you up to date as we move forward.

In addition, we plan to have a series of outdoor Shofar blowings throughout the neighborhood on the second day of Rosh Hashanah, in addition to the Shofar blowing at the minyan. We will publicize times and venues as well. We can also organize private shofar blowing for individuals who cannot access any of these venues. More information will be forthcoming in the coming days and weeks.
